Treat Jars

You'll Need:

- * A clean container, we used a coffee tin can, glass jam jar & plastic peanut butter jar
- * Pictures of horse cut from magazines
- * Scissors
- * White glue, or mod podge purchased from a craft store
- * Water
- * Bowl
- * Paintbrush

Step 1:

Trim the horse pictures as you like.

Step 2:

Thin a spoonful of glue with water in a bowl.

Brush the back of the pictures with the glue mixture and attach them to the jar.

Step 3:

Arrange pictures as you like on your container. Let the glue dry, then seal with another coat of the glue mixture painted on the outside of the pictures. This will keep your jars looking good for a long time.

Step 4:

To decorate the lid with fabric, place a bowl slightly larger than the lid on the inside of the fabric. Trace the bowl with a pencil. Cut out, and paint the inside of the fabric with glue mixture. Attach to the lid and tie it with ribbon or binder twine.

Other Ideas

Cover the container with material. Use dimensional craft paint and draw designs onto the treat jars in horse barns or barn themes. Carrots, horseshoes and apples are some ideas. Stickers, beads and ribbon are all fun things to decorate your treat jars with.

Fill your jars with treats for yourself, for your horse, or give them away as gifts. Whoever gets to enjoy the good stuff inside will appreciate your handy work.
